The *Gift of Life Family House*, working with the Transplant Foundation, a 501(c)(3) organization, is a program of the *Gift of Life Donor Program*. Since 1974, *Gift of Life Donor Program* has served as the region's non-profit organ and tissue donor program providing the link between patients awaiting organ and tissue transplants and those who donate. To date, *Gift of Life* has coordinated more than 28,000 organ transplants. *Gift of Life Donor Program* serves eastern Pennsylvania, southern New Jersey and Delaware.
